Important Trailer Rental Information (Camping)

Our Trailers:

- Our 13ft trailer rental rates are \$125 per night weekdays, and \$150 per night weekends (Fri, Sat), and holidays with a 2 night rental minimum. Our larger, premium, air-conditioned trailers rent for \$150-200 per night. Trailer(s) that will be used for commercial purposes (Marketing events, weddings, film/photo shoots etc), will have a different rental rate, please inquire. **Please note: Our rates may increase for certain camping festivals due to rough roads and extreme conditions.**

- Our ultra-light trailers typically have a sink, cooler, propane stove, overhead fan, a convertible table/bed for 2, a single or double bunk in front for the kids (or smaller adults), retractable power cord to plug into an ac power source, and water hose connection.

- Please note: the onboard battery will not power any power intensive appliances such as a heater or an air-conditioner. If you'll be camping in areas without a power outlet to plug into, you may need to consider a gas powered generator (please check for availability).

- Most of our trailers are real vintage from the 60' through the 90's, and they'll likely have some imperfections, but they've been restored as close to original specifications as possible. They get rented frequently for camping and other functions and parts such as hinges, nuts, bolts, wiring, plumbing and seams can come loose on rare occasions during a trip. If something minor happens while en route, you will not be held responsible for the normal wear and tear. Our trailers go through an extensive inspection before they leave the lot, and we do not reimburse for things that may occur during your trip, this includes flat or punctured tires, appliances not working, small leaks etc.

Please, No Smoking In The Trailers!

Towing info:

- Please check your car's manual for tow capacity rating. Our 13ft trailers weigh about 1000 lbs, and our 16ft trailers are around 1800-2200 lbs (unloaded).

- A tow hitch is required on your vehicle with a ball size of either 1 7/8" (Most of our vintage trailers) or 2" (Annette, Space Odyssey, Barbra), with a flat, 4-pin connector for the trailer lights (Annette takes a 7-pin connector).

- The base of the ball should be approximately 15" - 16" from the ground for a nice, even pull. The trailer should be well leveled so that the hitch or the bumper will not drag on the ground (ie: when going in and out of driveways or parking lots). This will also give you better gas mileage.
- Make ample use of your car's side mirrors, take slower, wider turns than usual and go over bumps slowly.
- Backing up with a trailer can be extremely tricky. If you're not too experienced, it's best to have someone else spot you. (Remember, Left is right and right is left when backing up a trailer).
- Please follow the speed limit for towing vehicles, and do not use the car pool lanes. Generally, drive in the right-hand lanes.
- **Please do not drink and drive.**

Insurance:

- The renter/driver is responsible for liability insurance, Please notify your insurance company before trailer pick up, that you'll be towing a 1000 - 2200 lbs, 1-axel trailer.
- We offer an optional trailer damage waiver for an additional \$25 per night, if required.
- For extended rentals, we recommend adding AAA travel insurance.

Pickup>Returns:

- Trailer pickup and returns are generally during our office hours (10a-5p), but we can accommodate to your specific needs (Fees may apply). To schedule pickup/return times, and additional questions, please call **(470) 222-6728**
- Trailer return time must be within 4 hours of your pickup time (within our office hours). A half night's rental fee may be charged if trailer is returned over 4 hours later than your pickup time.

- Please return trailer in the same approximate condition as when picked up, or cleaning fees may apply.
- If the trailer you've reserved are too damaged from unforeseen circumstances (eg, wreck from previous rental), a substitute trailer may be necessary.
- Please call or text at least an hour before trailer return.

Delivery Service:

- We offer a delivery & pickup service at \$30-40 per hour (2 hr minimum each way, round trip), plus 40 cents per mile for mileage.

Cancellations:

- There are no cancellations within 30 days of your rental reservation, but we'll do our very best to accommodate any changes in your schedule.
- No shows, without notice, will be charged the full rental amount.

Miscellaneous:

- Most of our trailers are equipped with convertible double bunks, with a 130lbs weight limit for the top bunk. Also, the top bunk's approximately 4ft high, so there's a risk of falling off. Use at your own discretion.
- During your travels with our trailers, things like screws and battery terminals can come loose due to bumps and vibrations from the road, and the age of our trailers. Please bring a basic tool kit.
- We do not supply bedding, cooking ware, plates, cups, utensils etc.
- Please do not pack any breakable personal items into the trailer closets and cabinets during transit, they may fall out.
- For rentals of over 3 nights, having a trickle charger for the trailer battery (trailers without solar panels), can be helpful.
