What makes Happier Camper Travel Trailers special?

There are many factors that make our Happier Camper Ultra Light trailers special, but We believe the main two would be:

1. Under 1200 lbs (so can easily be pulled with any car)
2. Small enough to fit in a single parking space.

What are the Benefits of a Happier Camper over conventional Trailers and RVs.

Where do I begin? There are many reasons but here is a short list:

- Eco friendly, Solar powered and self contained.
- Constructed of lightweight fiberglass, not only do they last forever, they can virtually be pulled by any car with the right hitch. All trailers weigh less then 1300lbs!
- Each uniquely equipped with the comforts of home, such as:

mini kitchenette (gas stove, fridge, sink)
Sleeping room For 4
Heat/Ac
Solar powered lighting

dining nook
storage/closets
couch
...and more!

- Small enough to get into those "hard to reach places" (usually the best places)
- Easy on gas so it's good for our wallet!
- They're cuties!

How much does it cost to rent a Happier Camper trailer?

Weekday & Off Season (Sept-May) rates start at \$100/day*

Weekend, Peak Season (June-Sept) & Holiday rates start at \$125/day*

*2 Day minimum and \$500 refundable cash or Credit Card deposit required on all rentals. Please contact us for exact quote and details

Can you deliver a Happier Camper trailer to our campsite?

YES! We can definitely deliver our trailers to your camping destination and set it up no problem for an additional fee. Delivery fee is generally \$50 each way. (\$100 for delivery and pickup) within 20 miles radius. For destinations over 20 miles, please let us know at the time of rental, which then can be discussed!

Is there a bathroom, toilet or shower?

No, our lil trailers don't have bathrooms, they are generally used for short weekend trips. But most campgrounds have clean bathrooms with showers for use. (Nobody said you couldn't use the sink & baby wipes!) Upon request we have portable toilets for rent, they must be thoroughly cleaned after use or you will lose your deposit.

Is there insurance on the lil trailers?

Contact your insurance company and advise them you will be pulling a Ultra Light 1 axel travel trailer (under 1300 lbs) and make sure its covered under your auto policy. There should be no cost.

What happens if there's an accident?

If an accident occurs, please contact the local authorities your insurance carrier and us (310 806 1856) in that order. Please drive safely. Assistance with roadside help, repair may be available, please refer to rental agreement.

How do I back up correctly?

Backing up a trailer can be difficult, but gets easier with practice. The best practice I find is to never put your self in a situation where you have to back up to begin with! This means parking in less populated areas in parking lots, taking up tow spaces and finding the "sweet spot" in every situation (in Parking and in Life). If you do find yourself in a "back up" situation, simple rule to remember is "Right is now Left" and "Left is now Right" (opposite of normal backing up). Be sure to use your mirrors and have a friend get out & guide you. Always exercise caution & take it slow.

What do I need to pull one of your lil trailers?

A vehicle with a trailer hitch, a 1 7/8" diameter ball and a 4-pin connector for the lights. The local U-haul location should be able to assist you. For other options please contact us.

Things to keep in mind while pulling the trailers?

There are many road precautions when pulling any trailer, most are common sense:

- Take it slow and easy, observe all city speed limits for vehicles with trailers!
- **SPACE** between other cars, for braking. If there's no room for 3 cars to park between you & the car in front of you, **YOU** are **TO CLOSE**.
- Obey all posted street signs.
- Allow **SPACE** for turns, you are pulling a trailer so watch out for posts (especially at gas stations)
- Steady & easy on big hills, with smaller vehicles in some cases you may need to downshift.
- Always watch your temperature gauge.
- Avoid big bumps, the lil trailers really bounce! Try to keep things like liquids inside your vehicle.
- Avoid "back up" situations park where there's less cars or where you can pull through.
- Before leaving make sure tail lights are fully operational, the hitch is secure and chains are correctly placed.
- Avoid difficult & one way roads.
- Never text, use cell phone while driving

Is my Pet(s) Allowed?

Sure!! We love furry critters (or slimy, wet, or feathery). Just be sure to clean up after them. And make sure they don't tear up the place :)

What is the maximum (height) clearance of the trailers?

The minimum clearance for the trailers is 9'. Actual height of the Happier Camper is about 7.5' you never know when someone forgets to close the roof vent. Better to Be careful, then be sorry! Its always best to avoid things close to the roof, this includes tree branches!

How Much do the Happier Camper trailers weigh?

All our trailers are Ultra Lights and weigh between 970 – 1300 lbs

How do I control the temperature inside.

All our trailers have high powered ceiling or window fans, sometimes its best to reverse the fan and suck the hot air out. The lil trailers warm easily with a little body heat. For heating We provide you with a AC Heater to use when plugged in. Do not use a Propane heater inside the trailer or the Propane stove, this is a fire hazard and can be toxic.

Where are the hooks ups Located?

The power and water hook ups are on the side of the trailer, plug the water hose from the camping spot into the water intake, plug the 110v power plug into the sites power, use extension cord provided if needed. Which we will go over with you.

Are the trailers hard to clean?

The lil trailers are easy to clean but tend to get dirty FAST. Its important to always keep it clean and organized inside or you will find yourself with a mess quick. Good packing skills and organization can go a long way. Sweeping the floors daily, wiping down the sink and food area, dusting off pillows and cushions and folding cloths is a must. To clean the outside its best to pull into a "do-it-yourself" wash bay, they're cheap and convenient way to wash the trailers.

What other camping supplies do you offer?

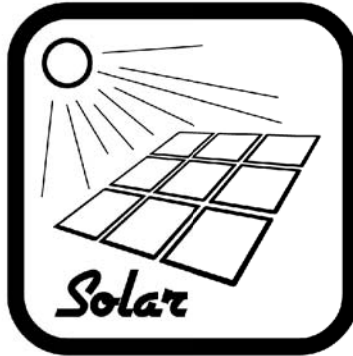
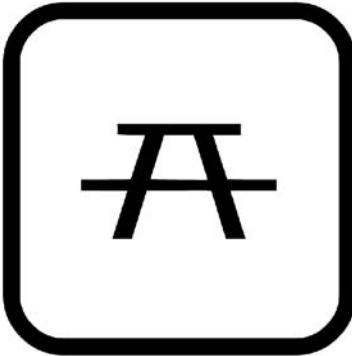
